REFER APPLICANTS

Individuals and families at risk and housing insecure apply to Entryway.



SCREEN APPLICANTS

Applicants are screened and assessed for program eligibility.



TRAIN PARTICIPANTS

Entryway upskills with Grace Hill virtual classroom courses and in-person, hands-on classroom trainings taught by apartment industry professionals for careers in groundskeeping, maintenance, and leasing.



HIRE PARTICIPANTS

Trained participants are referred to our network of more than 80 companies in need of on-site talent to manage their apartment communities.



RETURN TO SELF-SUFFICIENCY

Hired Entryway participants receive full-time employment, benefits, and discounted housing opportunities at or near their employment site.
