- Maintenance/Service Technician Skilled in trades such as plumbing, HVAC, electrical, carpentry, drywall, and painting combined with exceptional customer service skills. Certifications are a plus. Entryway offers training opportunities for certifications.
- **Groundskeeper** General labor candidates with experience in landscaping, grounds maintenance, custodial, and the safe use of various electronic tools to help create a beautiful environment for residents.
- Leasing/Sales Experience in sales and customer service and enjoy interacting with the public.
